NUR 100: Basic Nursing Assistant Training

Hours: 131

Student to instructor ratio: 20/1 classroom, 10/1 clinical situations

Educational Requirements: Completion of the 8th grade.

Pre-Requisites: None.

The Basic Nursing Assistant Training Program curriculum is designed to prepare individuals to deliver direct patient care in long-term facilities, home healthcare settings, clinics, doctor's offices and hospitals, under the direction of a registered nurse. An accelerated program held several times each year, the course of study provides the opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills used by nursing assistants. Clinical training for all students is held at participating healthcare facilities. Upon enrollment in the program, all students will undergo a criminal background check and must meet the requirements for courses with clinical components. Upon successful completion of the program, graduates will receive a J' Renee certificate of completion and be eligible to sit for the Illinois state exam. BNAT meets the requirements and guidelines set by the State of Illinois Department of Public Health for Basic Nurse Assistant Programs.

Educational Requirements: High school diploma or GED.

Pre-Requisites: Must be a healthcare student, or healthcare worker. Possess dexterity to properly manipulate EKG equipment effectively.

The EKG course curriculum prepares healthcare students and workers in the basics of reading EKG strips. The course of study provides opportunity to acquire knowledge and skills used by healthcare workers who read EKGs as part of their job responsibilities. The EKG content focus is on anatomy and electrophysiology of the heart, identifying normal and abnormal heart rhythms on the EKG monitor, and responding appropriately in emergencies. After successful completion of the program, graduates will receive a **J' Renee certificate of completion**.

The Practical Nursing Program at J' Renee Career Facilitation, Inc. prepares students to provide nursing care to clients with normal and common health problems through the use of basic nursing skills under the direction of a registered professional nurse or licensed physician. Based on the Adult Learning Theory, the program consists of classroom instruction, faculty supervised simulation laboratory and clinical experiences in hospitals, long-term care facilities, and community health care settings. The Practical Nursing program is a full-time, one-year program that is approved by the Illinois Department of Financial and Professional Regulation, the Illinois State Board of Education and the Illinois State Board of Nursing.
